# Rocket Talk January 21, 2021

## **Instructional Setting Survey**

- District leaders are reviewing school re-opening plans for the 2020-2021 year.
- Re-opening schools will remain contingent on many factors including Health Department policies.
- District wants to be prepared in case things change. Administration needs honest responses, not hopeful ones to prepare properly.
- Everyone is encouraged to complete the new survey so District and Prisk leadership can plan based on current opinions of the community.
- The survey is due on February 5 by 5:00 pm PT.

## Q: What will the in-person schedule look like?

A: The in-person schedule will be "half day" just like our current remote learning schedules. Students enrolled in in-person will attend an AM or PM session as assigned. There will be **no** full day option.

## Q: If we return in-person, are we guaranteed to keep our teacher and group?

A: That is not guaranteed, but it is our top priority to do so to the greatest extent possible. Classes that don't have an balanced number of survey responses may also cause some student moves.

#### Q: Will students keep the same teacher?

A: That is our hope. However, based on this survey's results that may not be possible. We need a balance of numbers. For example, if half the class wants to stay online and half want to attend in-person, a teacher can do one session online and the other in-person. However, if only 5 students want online or in-person, class composition may have to be reconsidered. Parents will be notified of any change to their child's class assignment and given opportunity to discuss options.

## Q: Can we choose in-person now and change it to online later?

A: We need to be honest and submit real answers based on **<u>current</u>** expectations to prepare for a potential reopening. This is the only way the District can obtain valid responses and plan properly.


## Q: Will all our teachers be able to receive a vaccine before they return?

A: This is unknown. LBUSD was expected to receive 10,000 vaccines this week to begin to vaccinate their employees. They only received 1,000. As soon as more vaccines are available, more educators will be able to make their appointments.

## Q: How do I respond to the survey?


A: Login into ParentVUE (via website or mobile app) and follow these steps:

- 1. On the left navigation menu, click on "School of Choice".
- 2. Under the "School of Choice" links displayed on the right, select "Parents Click To Choose an Instructional Setting".
- 3. In the next screen, your previous survey's selection will be displayed along with your mailing address.
- 4. To submit this new survey, click the "Review" button on the bottom right.
- 5. Your previous survey's response will be marked as "SELECTED". To change your selection, select the button marked as "SELECT".
- 6. Verify your desired selection's button is marked "SELECTED".
- 7. Click the "FINISH" button to confirm your survey selection. An email will be sent immediately afterwards to verify your selection.
